Teaching Kids about Financial Literacy

Sayreville, NJ – April 16, 2010 Raritan Bay Federal Credit Union, along with Money Management, will raise financial awareness at Cardinal McCarrick High school on Wednesday, April 21, 2010 and South Amboy Middle/High School on Friday, April 23, 2010. Raritan Bay FCU and Money Management will make a presentation to students, including games and an open discussion, on the importance of financial literacy.

Raritan Bay FCU will also speak to the students about the benefits of Credit Union membership. Students will be advised to take advantage of the *Lighthouse* (located in South Amboy Middle/High School) and the *Eagle's Nest* (located in Cardinal McCarrick High School). The *Lighthouse* and the *Eagle's Nest* are student-run offices of the Credit Union, which operate within the high schools, two days a week.

National Credit Union Youth Week is April 18-24, 2010. Struggling for economic prosperity is difficult for everyone. It's especially hard for young people who've never learned how to plan to achieve financial security. What we need today, confirmed by poor financial literacy test scores from across the country, is leadership to help raise the awareness of financial issues for young people.
